







From the artist

Despite the easing of the pandemic, people of all nationalities are facing challenging and difficult circumstances, globally and individually. It is in this context that it is worth remembering that we do not walk alone. Referencing Jesus' words in Matthew ("I am with you always"), I felt it would be apposite to theme this exhibition around 'Footprints'. The allegorical poem Footprints in the Sand, in which two sets of footprints merge into one during troubled times, and we are reminded by God that "it was then that I carried you", echoes Jesus' words. My artistic stimulus has recently been drawn from Israel where I found walking in the footsteps of Christ both moving and inspirational, artistically and spiritually. Christ himself said at the end of his ministry; "I am with you always". Mathew 28:20. I hope that whatever you are facing in life you will be reminded of these words. I hope too, that the paintings in the exhibition, of which there are 100 or so, will convey a sense of peace, hope and

companionship.













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


Footprints towards the sun Oil 20 x 20cm




Station of the Cross I: Via Dolorosa, Jerusalem Mixed media on canvas 20 x 20cm




Station II: Jesus carries the cross Mixed media on canvas 20 x 20cm




Station III: Jesus stumbles Mixed media 20 x 20cm





Sunset from the mill Oil 20 x 20cm

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

Rory graduated from the Chelsea School of Art in 1988 and soon established his reputation as a contemporary landscape artist by winning a number of awards and exhibiting widely, including in the Royal Academy. His early work focused on vibrant and richly textured city landscapes and gradually widened in subject to feature a variety of rural landscapes, meeting with increasing national and international recognition. Rory's paintings draw us in to feel a sense of place and that we are "in situ" in every location, as well as enabling us to catch a glimpse of his own faith.
